The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) – Drinking Water Program (DWP) has received and reviewed the following submissions made by your public water system (PWS):

- Service Line Inventory (SLI)
- SLI Certification Form
- Certification of Non-Lead Service Lines and request for Approval Form

**Your PWS initial service line inventory (SLI) and accompanying documentation meets the requirements outlined in the Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) (40 CFR 141.84(a)) and MassDEP/DWP requirements with the following conditions:**

- This letter of approval is for the approval of the SLI and accompanying documentation that was submitted by your PWS to meet the October 16, 2024, LCRR initial SLI requirement deadline.
- MassDEP/DWP will be validating your data before submittal to EPA, so we may require additional information and/or minor corrections after this approval letter.
- The LCRR contains additional requirements beyond the required information that was included in the initial SLI, including a requirement to make your SLI accessible to consumers. Please review and follow the Associated Requirements checked below and on the attached factsheet to ensure that your PWS is in compliance with these requirements.
- Depending on the composition of your SLI, there may be additional federal or MassDEP requirements your PWS must follow to maintain compliance. Please review

the Associated Requirements section checked below and on the attached factsheet and take all additional actions identified for your PWS:

### Associated SLI Requirements

Attached with this document, and available on the [LCRR MassDEP website](#), is the **Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) and MassDEP DWP Associated Service Line Inventory (SLI) Requirements factsheet**.
