Mr. Szczurko called the meeting to order at 11:13am.

ITEM 1: Declaration of Water Supply Conservation

Mr. Coveney outlined the reasons for the need to declare an emergency declaration of water supply conservation. Summarized pump failure at Pleasant Valley Well; Mr. Muscente questions whether spare pumps should be purchased, Mr. Coveney feels that a spare for this particular well should be purchased and available. Mr. Muscente also questioned whether this pump could be rebuilt, which it cannot.

Mr. Coveney summarized the steps needed to be taken through Mass DeP as well as the steps the District would enact to notify the public of the temporary ban on non-essential outdoor watering as written in the District's bylaws, section 6.4.

Mr. Bryngelson moved to declare a state of water supply conservation and to allow the Superintendent to enforce any water use restrictions set forth in the District Bylaws Section 6. Mr. Mard seconded the motion, all voted in favor, motion carried.

Mr. Mard moved to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Bryngelson seconded the motion, all voted in favor, Mr. Szczurko adjourned the meeting at 11:32.
