Mr. LaMountain called the meeting to order at 5:03pm.

ITEM 1: NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Richard Simmarano of 98 Shrewsbury Street requested an abatement on water usage lost during a pipe break in basement. Board cited Rules and Regulations of the Water District and denied request. Mr. Coveney will work with Mr. Simmarano to calculate approximate water loss in the event he wants to ask the Sewer commissioners for an abatement, and advised putting in an insurance claim.

ITEM 3: OLD BUSINESS

OAKDALE WATER TREATMENT PLANT: Michael Carmasine of Comprehensive Environmental (CEI) updated the Board on construction progress of the Oakdale Water Treatment Plant. Approximately 80% of work has been completed and invoiced. Well cleaning and pump will be installed; permanent power would be complete in next week to two weeks. Contract completion date was 10/18; on track for December 13th completion. Presented the change order: relocation of flow meter and chemical injection based on contractor experience. Mr. LaMountain questioned whether this was a design flaw; Mr. Carmasine did not think so; Waterline Industries advised that issues may arise and this change order would correct any issues that would possibly happen. Approximate cost is \$4500.00. The Board agreed that this was wise and approved and signed the change order. Mr. Carmasine advised that CEI would be looking to amend their contract to provide services beyond the anticipated 10/18 completion date.

LEE STREET MAIN REPLACEMENT: Mr. Carmasine updated the Board on progress of engineering the replacement/moving of the water main on Lee Street, which included soil borings (7) scheduled for 10/18/22 and finishing the survey to start contract documents in November. Advised preliminary design plan would be available in approximately a month. Mr. Coveney questioned property line inaccuracies; Mr. Carmasine noted that CEI overlaid lines provided by GIS (Geographic Information System) but was still looking for bounds to verify property lines. Mr. Coveney advised that the State may have highway bounds and would guide and assist CEI. Mr. Carmasine noted that surveyors would be on Lee Street week of 10/24/22.

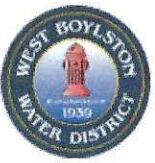
ITEM 4: APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Mr. Bryngelson made a motion to adjourn; Mr. Mard seconded the motion; all voted in favor. Mr. LaMountain adjourned the meeting at 6:11 PM. Next meeting scheduled for November 14, 2022 at 5pm.

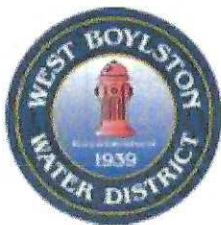

- 1.) Oakdale Treatment Facility: The contractor is currently working on the interior piping, electrical, HVAC and site work. The Oakdale Well is on schedule to be shut down for cleaning and upgrades starting next week. Mike Carmasine from CEI will be able to attend the meeting today for an update. Pay requisition #15 is included on the warrant to be signed today. We need to discuss the dedication plaque wording. I have provided a copy of some examples of these for review. There is also a change order to discuss.
 - 2.) Lee Street Water Main project: CEI is working on the survey for the Lee St. project. They will be working on subsurface soil borings this week.
 - 3.) Hydrant Claim: The hydrant at the intersection of Woodland St and Pierce St has been replaced and the driver of the vehicle has been billed. We have been working with our attorney on this to recover our expenses from Geico Insurance and the driver. They are working out an agreement to proceed.
 - 4.) Rte. 12 Pump Station Flooding: I have contacted the owner of the development and Walmart about this issue. Walmart has agreed to repair the collapsed 48" drain under the entrance to the Scarlett Brook Marketplace. Their contractor is delayed with other work, and they are looking into other local contractors to proceed with this project.
 - 5.) Pleasant Valley Well #2: Manganese update, the detection levels are below the health advisory of 0.30 mg/L but above the secondary MCL of 0.05 mg/L. The average monthly sample result is 0.12 mg/L. We will continue to sample and monitor this each month for any changes.
 - 6.) Part time office position: I would like the Board to consider revisiting the part time office position. I would like to propose re-opening the position for part time office help with a minimum of 20hrs per week. This would be helpful to share some of the workload with Lori and when she is not in the office, we would be able to keep the office open if I am unable to staff the office myself. This position was formerly held by Mary G. who retired in 2016.
